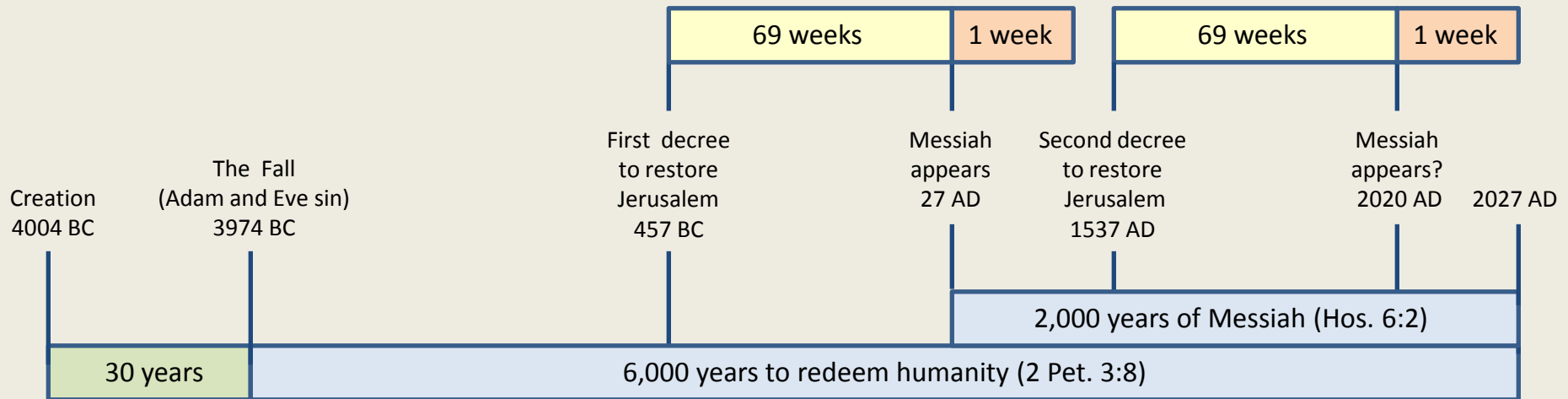


Possible Dual Fulfillment of Daniel's 70 Weeks

(6,000-Year Timeline Based on James Ussher's Chronology)



The 6,000-year plan of redemption wasn't necessary until Adam and Eve sinned. While Scripture doesn't reveal how much time passed between Creation and Adam's temptation and fall, we know that Jesus, the "second Adam," had been on earth about 30 years when He was tempted by Satan and triumphed (1 Cor. 15:45; Luke 3:23; 4:1, 2). In the Bible, 30 is the age of maturity and accountability (Num. 4:3; 2 Sam. 5:4; Gen. 41:46). If the first Adam was, like Jesus, tempted by the Devil after 30 years, the fall of man may have occurred 30 years after Creation, in 3974 BC.
