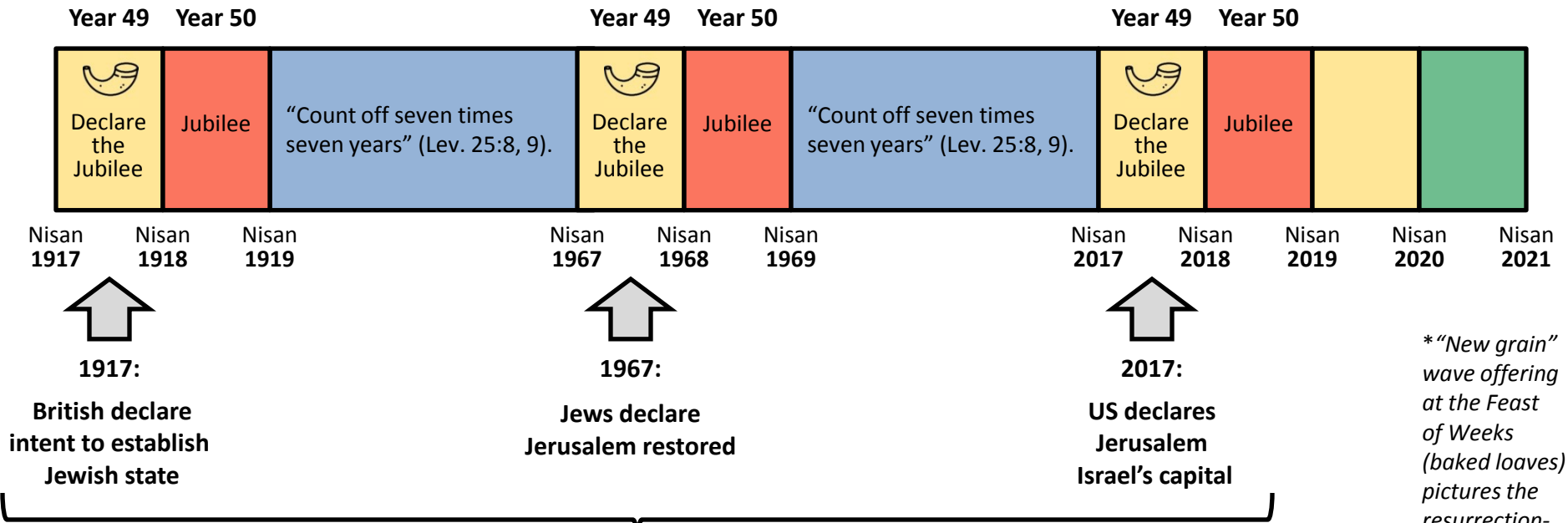
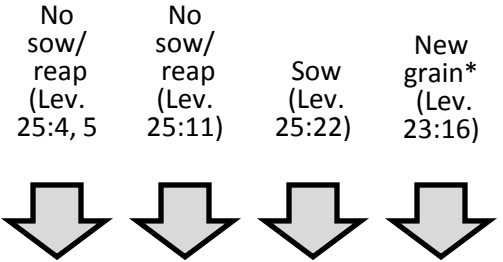


Jubilee and the Harvest

“Count off ... seven times seven years ... a period of forty-nine years. Then [in the 49th year] have the trumpet sounded everywhere Consecrate [set apart] the fiftieth year and proclaim liberty throughout the land to all its inhabitants The fiftieth year shall be a jubilee for you; *do not sow and do not reap what grows of itself or harvest the untended vines*” (Lev. 25:8-11).
