

Peace Plan Delayed Again

THE Deal of the Century seems destined to be known as the “Delay” of the Century.

Due to continuing uncertainty around the formation of Israel’s next government, US officials are saying the rollout of the Trump peace plan is likely to be delayed yet again.

In the weeks leading up to the September 17 election, officials were saying the plan would be unveiled very soon or immediately after the vote. However, the deadlock results and ongoing uncertainty around who will lead Israel next means the plan may not be rolled out for months.
